

# CALL FOR PAPERS

## Who Are We? Where Are We Going?

The Institute of Native American Studies at the University of Georgia is hosting the second interdisciplinary meeting in Native American and Indigenous studies April 10-12, 2008 to share research and continue the discussion of development of an academic association for our field. We invite submissions of individual papers or panels of papers on any topic in Native American and Indigenous studies. All persons working in the field are invited and encouraged to submit proposals.

The steering committee is inviting proposals from scholars around the globe for individual papers or panels of papers on any topic in Native American and Indigenous studies. Only **complete** proposals will receive full consideration.

**Deadline for submissions is December 1, 2007.**

For an individual paper proposal to be complete, it must contain the speaker's name, institutional affiliation, if any, the paper's title, and an abstract of no more than 250 words. A complete panel proposal will contain a title for the panel, the names and affiliations, if any, of all the speakers, titles and a brief précis for all individual presentations, a person designated as chair, and an abstract of no more than 250 words for the panel as a whole. If the panel is an alternative format, such as a roundtable, this must be stated in the abstract and individual paper titles may be dispensed with.

All proposals must specify audio/visual needs. The fee for a/v needs is \$25 for an individual paper and \$50 for a complete panel. Please note, in the case of PowerPoint presentations, projectors will be provided. Individuals must supply their own computers. Submissions should be sent either by regular mail or email to:
